The MSc in Supply Chain Management & Purchasing provides a unique opportunity for acquiring a specialist qualification in the area of purchasing, supply chain management, combined with a generalised one in project management. This MSc programme is designed for practising professionals, mid-career managers and graduates seeking specialised training in these complementary fields at managerial level.

- The MSc offers a dual competency in supply chain management, and purchasing & project management.
