ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN GREEN BUSINESS MANAGEMENT AND SUSTAINABILITY (GRMT)

This program is ideally suited for those professionals interested in venturing into the evolving business movement, of managing companies and organizations that are green or greening themselves. The GRMT program has many elements of a traditional business management program, at the same time it provides professionals with the knowledge, skills and tools to direct companies and organizations towards environmental and economic sustainability.

The GRMT program consists of six general management courses (21 credits) that will allow students to develop business-related critical thinking, analytical skills, communication skills, teamwork and interpersonal skills. They will also develop skills in the management of innovation and digital transformation. Following this, students complete 15 credits of Green business specialty courses.

The admissions requirement for the **Graduate Diploma in Green Business Management and Sustainability** is as follows:

- A qualified applicant **must** meet KPU's [English Proficiency Requirements for Admission](#)
- Successful completion of a recognized undergraduate* or graduate degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.67. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and relevant professional experience may be considered for the program.
- A statement of intent in the program, including relevant studies and work experience. This letter should be 800 – 1000 words and cover the following:
 - Intellectual and creative interests
 - Personal goals related to the program
 - How previous background contributes to the program
 - Self-assessment of emotional intelligence with applied examples
 - Highlight community involvement interests
- Two professional references stating suitability for the program.

Selection of Applicants

- All applicants are assessed by an admissions committee for maturity, academic program fit, educational background and work experience through the statement of intent and references.
- Applicants may be interviewed by a member of the Admissions Committee as part of the application screening process.
- Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into the program.



GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN GLOBAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT (IBUS)

The Graduate Diploma in Global Business Management is designed for individuals that want to actively and constructively participate in global business opportunities and challenges. Whether the participants have industry experience or are starting their career in industry, the program is designed to prepare them to successfully address supervisory and managerial needs in a business environment.

The Global Business Management consists of six general core courses (21 credits). Following those courses, students complete five specialty courses (15 credits) including a graduate experience practicum.

The admissions requirement for the **Graduate Diploma in Global Business Management** is as follows:

- A qualified applicant **must** meet KPU's [English Proficiency Requirements for Admission](#)
- Successful completion of a recognized undergraduate* or graduate degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.67. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and relevant professional experience may be considered for the program.
- A statement of intent in the program, including relevant studies and work experience. This letter should be 800 – 1000 words and cover the following:
