UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Completion of accredited high school with 3.00/4.00 GPA (70 or higher on Canadian grading scale)
- If less than 3.0 GPA, submission of SAT or ACT scores
- Adequate financial support documents for one year of study
- Online application and \$50 application fee
- Minimum TOEFL-iBT of 61 or IELTS 5.5 or completion of level 5 at the English Language Institute
